

Gen'ii Holiday the first event in October

A tradition blending the old drinking and easy living days of the Gen'ii that has blended together with the days of the Fendenglades. The herds gather in their long-halls to listen to stories of great fallen warriors from within the tribe while drinking in their honor. People take turns telling a story of great accomplishments in battle that helped make the herd what it is today, then raising a toast at the end of each in remembrance. In larger herds, this can go on all night, often ending with the rising of the sun...or the last to pass out from drunkenness. It is often tradition to leave one seat at the gathering with a mug of untouched alcohol for any past spirits that wish to sit and listen in. Drinking this mug is considered extremely taboo as it risks angering the ancestor who may then possess the imbiber and cause them great misfortune. Taking their seat merely brings minor misfortune, whether intentional or not.
